- 1. Reviewing the Vocational Labour Regulatory Law and endorsing the validating reasons for its amendments

- 4. Enrolling 1000 female and male trainees in the training project in the construction sector

Adopting all bylaws related to the enforcement of the new inspection law

- Preparing the Judicial Institute and Justice Palace halls for a distance learning project
- 2. Enforcing the Draft of Civil Procedure Code

Engineering and Construction

- Completion of infrastructure works for assembly plants in Madaba
- 2. Licensing of occupations in the construction sector
- 3. Sending a recommendation to the Cabinet to issue a law obliging ministries, state-owned companies and the private sector to set a quota for Jordanian contractors in international tenders in Jordan
